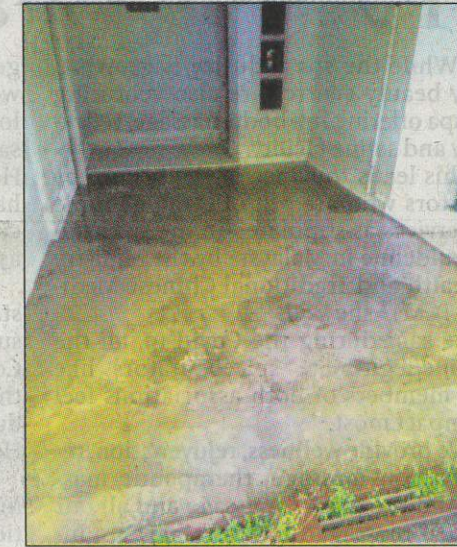
LABUAN: Torrential rain the last few days caused several areas to be flooded, including the road leading to the Labuan Universiti Malaysia Sabah (UMS) campus.

A staff of UMS who did not want to be named said the flooding was at a road curve near the institution and this was dangerous, especially at night as a driver may find the area tricky and end up having an accident.
