

Rozman is sticking to Warisan

KOTA KINABALU: Labuan MP Datuk Rozman Isli (**pic**) says he remains firmly with Parti Warisan Sabah and dismissed any hints that he was ready to become an independent.



He said that the statement he made at Astro Awani recently that there was no problem to being an independent elected representative did not give the true picture of his interview.

Rozman was referring to the Awani news report on Jun 21 titled "Tiada Masalah Jadi Wakil Rakyat Bebas (No Problem Being an Independent Elected Representative)".

He said that in the interview, he was just giving a general view that Labuan could be represented by any elected representative including an independent, as the government of the day would continue to develop the offshore financial centre.

"I was just giving a broad general view," he said in a statement Monday (June 22).
